This course is designed to give students clarity and conviction about the New Testament and its relevance to today. To equip them for this task, students will spend time listening to lectures, discussing course materials, reading and studying the Scripture, completing homework assignments, in-class quizzes, tests, and presentations. Students will be expected to attend class regularly, on time, having completed all reading and homework assignments before class begins. We will utilize the Bible as our primary textbook. The instructor will use the ESV, but students are not required to use this translation. The goal for the first semester is proficiency in the structure and message of the New Testament. The goal for the second semester is proficiency in understanding how to read, use, and interpret the New Testament, with an eye toward defending the reliability and truthfulness of the message found in it.
