This can look like making clay models or drawing our own ancient coin designs... to building 3d maps or learning to weave! The goal isn't necessarily to have a beautiful finished piece, but for your child to learn and retain information from the act of creating and exploring!



Overview:

I love history and I believe that it doesn't have to be stuffy and boring! In this class we will go back in time, this year, to the Middle Ages! We will learn from occasional videos, encyclopedias and stories about important times, places and people.

We will also learn important geography skills and concepts as we make our way around the world during this time period. I also enjoy contrasting our learning back to Gods word whenever I can, asking important questions relating or contrasting to the time period.

We will create timelines and discuss major events. We will reinforce this knowledge with hands on activities and projects in class. (Specifically, the type of projects you would love your child to experience, but don't really feel up to tackling at home!) We will practice note taking skills, which can involve actual writing/copy work as well as picture notes.

TUITION:

Materials Fee: \$50 non refundable due at registration.

Deposit is due at registration- \$25 non-refundable amount which is to be paid directly to REACH as you register for the class.

LAMP families: \$315 total tuition:this will come out to \$35 a month. If LAMP only provides partial pay, you will be responsible for the rest, which will be due by the second week of class. You are also responsible to self-pay for any missed LAMP payments due to dropping after third class or for not meeting LAMP requirements during the semester.

Self-pay families: will receive a \$15 discount for \$300 total tuition: full tuition or \$150 due the first day of class, September 4th , and again with second semester being due January 15th.

If the class is dropped after the second class of either semester, tuition is not refunded

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
